Heather Tiffée

Heather Tiffée is the Managing Attorney of Capital Pro Bono, formerly Voluntary Legal Services Program. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from UC Berkeley. While in law school at UC Davis she volunteered and became a staff member at CPB. After passing the bar, she returned to Capital Pro Bono as an attorney and has worked in that capacity since 2004. As the Managing Attorney, Heather oversees all basic functions of the organization, including grant writing, fundraising, volunteer recruitment, client outreach, and office management. She is also currently the primary Staff Attorney for CPB. In that capacity, she runs and supervises the Debt Collection and Employment Law Clinics, the Family Law Assistance and Misdemeanor Expungement Projects, and the referral of guardianship, conservatorship, estate planning, and probate cases to private attorneys for pro bono representation.
